



## **Facundo 2008**

### **Loncomilla**

The Carignan that goes into this wine comes from 50-year-old dry-farmed, bush-trained vines near Melozal. All of these characteristics provide us with tremendously balanced fruit that in turn allows us to make tremendously balanced wines.

Production: 8 tons/hectare

### **Itata**

The 12-year-old vineyard that produces our Cabernet Sauvignon is located in the rolling hills of the Bellavista sector of the valley. The soils are predominately granitic with approximately 30% clay. Add this to the climate in Chile's 8<sup>th</sup> Region, and the result is a fresh wine with very good structure and those much-desired graphite tannins.

Production: 7 tons/hectare

### **Lolol**

This warm zone is ideal for late-ripening varieties such as Petit Verdot. This young vineyard—just 6 years old—is located 5 km (3 mi) from the town of Lolol. It sits high on a hill, facing south and receives cool evening breezes. The soils are 100% granitic and allow the vines to grow slowly, develop good balance, and faithfully express their terroir.

Production: 4 tons/hectare
