Marina was born of the fruit of our love, our joy of life, and the pleasure we taking in enjoying whatever life brings our way.

This is a special selection of different clones from two vineyards. Fruit from clones 5 and 107, which are largely responsible for this wine's tremendous palate and freshness, comes from the El Estero vineyard, while the Mina del Agua property contributes clone 242, which delivers tremendous aromatic character and the distinctive tropical fruit that combines with the mineral aspects of clone 5 and the herbal notes of clone 107 for a fabulous blend.

We wanted this blend to reflect the style of wines that we like to drink at home with our friends and good food.
